Preserve Conserve Restore

PRESERVE

- act of preventing or neutralizing the deterioration of objects through proper storage and handling techniques.

CONSERVE

- the practice of mitigating further deterioration. Reversible stabilization is any treatment that can be undone with no ill effect to the artifact.

RESTORE

- attempts to return an artifact back to its original condition.
- restoration equals permanent change.
- “Once changed, an object’s provenance has also been altered and it is no longer a true document of its place in history.”

Handling the Item

- Clean station
- Clean hands
- “Never do anything to an artifact that you cannot undo”
- Some materials are or become chemically unstable
- “Retain the context”
 - Is it organized in an important or meaningful way?
 - Could give you information!
 - Avoid mixing up boxes/piles/collections

Care for Originals

- Supplies
 - Avoid acid-free papers whose surface pH registers above 8
 - pH pen
 - Plastics are not created equal
 - Passed P.A.T. (Photographic Activity Test)
 - safest for long-term storage

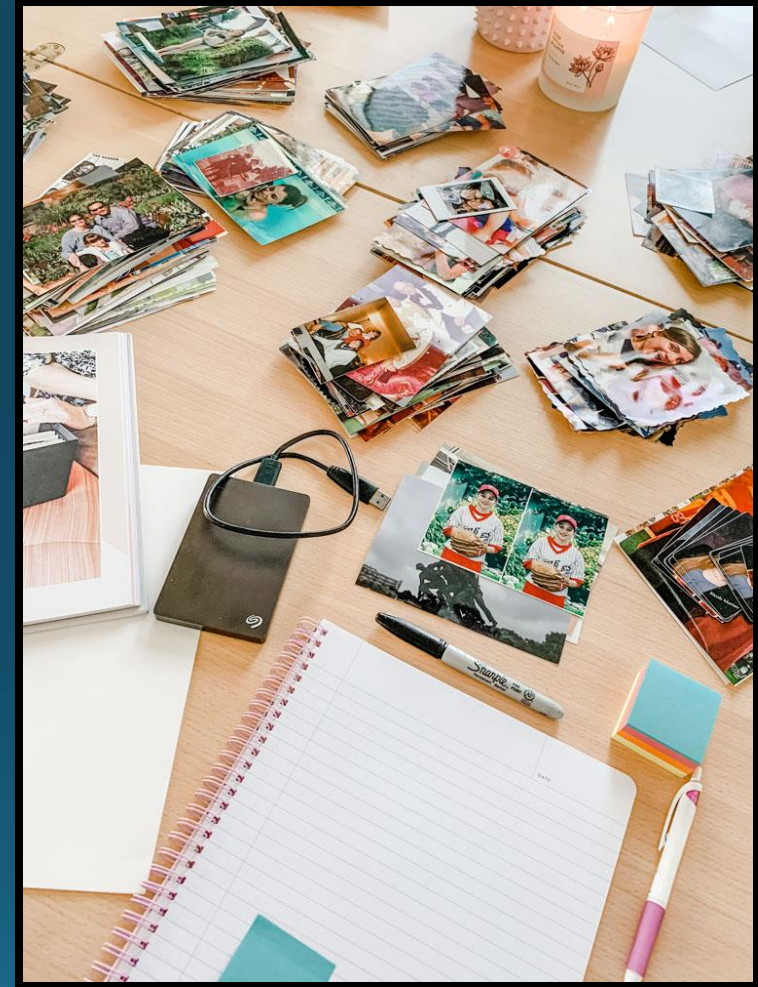

- Professionals
- DIY
 - Work Station
 - Equipment
- Where is it going?
- How is it going to get there?

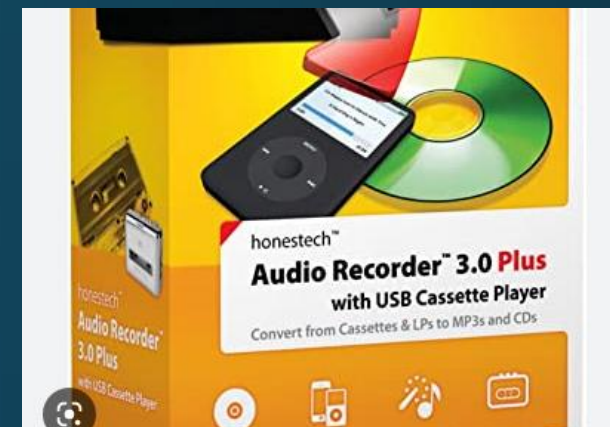
Workstation

- Stay out or pack away?
 - Kitchen table vs. office area
- Potential Hazards
 - Food/Beverage
 - Pets
 - Curious people
 - Windows/doors
 - Proximity concerns (candles, etc.)



Convert it: Audio

- Vinyl Record transfer
- Cassette tapes
- audacityteam.org
 - Audio editor
 - Free, open source software
- Microphones!
 - Lapel mics are friendly

- Audio/Visual Converter
- audacityteam.org
 - Audio editor





Convert it: Images

- Film to Digital converters
 - negatives, slides, some movie film, physical photos
- Reel2Digital converters
 - 8 mm and Super 8 film
- Photo Scanners
 - old photos = doesn't pull on or manipulate the original
- Your phone
 - use a stationary setup and diffused lighting
 - Buy lightbox or DIY



Getting a good picture of the picture

- Camera setup/stabilization
- Lighting- "soft & diffused"
- Photobox
 - Purchase
 - DIY
- Avoid "bullseye" lights or shadows

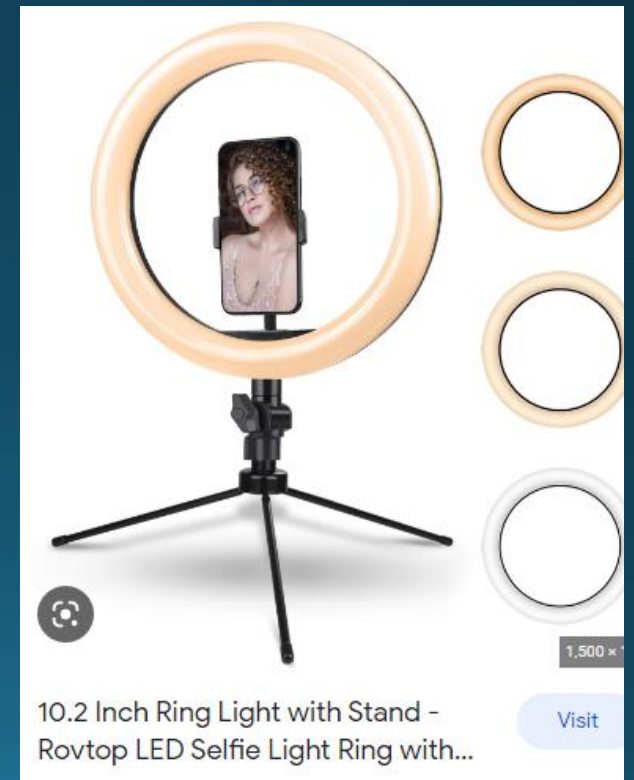
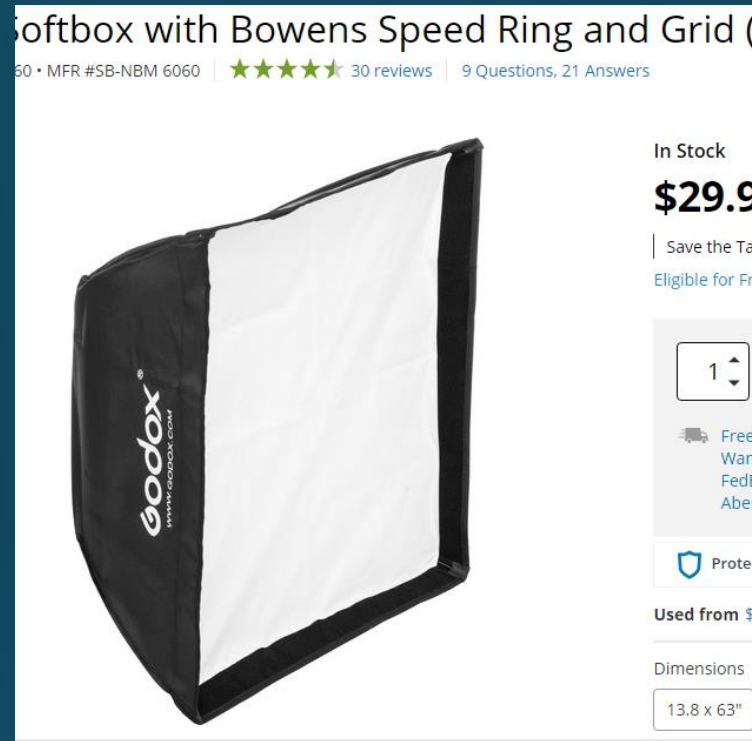


Image Files

.jpeg (aka .jpg)

- Balances file size and image quality
- Most common
- Compresses the image = fit more on your storage
 - Suitable for most needs, but you cannot blow them up for larger prints

.tiff

- For high-quality scans of images
 - Huge files!
- Sacrifices storage space (doesn't compress files)
- Best for images you plan to manipulate or enlarge
- Problems sharing – too big to send

Other types : .raw .pdf .png .heif .gif

Mail-in Services

- No time/space, etc. = Hire someone
- Sending originals = some risk
 - FotoBridge
 - iMemories
 - Legacybox
 - ScanMyPhotos

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DIY

Where should it go?

- Cloud services
 - Online
 - not lost if one device fails
 - Apps: Google Photos, iCloud Photo Library, Photo Vault, etc.
- External device
 - Memory card, hard drive, zip drive, etc.
- A device
 - Computer/iPad/Phone
 - Possible to lose the device, and your photos
- “There’s an app for that”

Databases Apps Platforms

- Watch for ...
 - Do you retain the rights to your photos?
 - Conversion quality
 - Can you enlarge it without losing clarity?
 - Prices and fees
 - What features do you want?
 - Sharing
 - Color correction and cropping (standard)

What about the stuff on my phone?

- Make it a routine
 - Download it – to a device or external storage or...
 - Upload it – to a cloud or database
- Organize it
 - Remove detritus
 - Use your Favorites Folder
 - Delete duplicates with software
 - PhotoSweeper
 - Photos Duplicate Cleaner

3-2-1 backup standard

- 3 Copies
- 2 Different types of media (computer + external hard drive)
- 1 copy off-site (iCloud, Google Photos, etc.)
